JOB TITLE: Senior Partnerships Manager

JOB PURPOSE: Develop and maintain strategic relationships with senior leaders within Vitae membership and the wider research and innovation system to identify new opportunities for partnerships, funding and collaborative projects. Deliver a programme of collaborative initiatives both nationally and internationally, in line with CRAC-Vitae's strategic goals.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Relationship building – Cultivate and track relationships with senior leaders within Vitae membership and the wider research and innovation (R&I) system, with a focus on professional bodies and organisations, funders, and governments.
- Proposal development and income generation – Undertake funder research, identify new opportunities, and lead on proposal development, ensuring coordinated, timely and professional responses to opportunities.
- Programme management - Manage a programme of varied projects that contribute to the delivery of CRAC-Vitae's organisational strategy, working with colleagues across the organisation to monitor progress and success indicators, and identifying opportunities to maximise our impact and influence.
- External communications – Support the Head of Policy and Engagement and Director of Programmes and Partnerships by preparing talking points and briefings, and collaborate with colleagues to produce and write reports, briefings, and other externally-facing materials.
- Analysis and expertise – Maintain the high level of knowledge about higher education and the wider R&I system necessary to effectively present CRAC-Vitae's work to external stakeholders and participate in external meetings and events. Keep track of trends in R&I, drawing on insights from the Community Engagement Manager.
- Continuous improvement - All team members take a continuous improvement approach to their work, contributing to the development of processes and ways of working, as well as organisational culture and strategy, providing insights and connections from their perspective.
